ingular Hotels (www. thesingular.com), of Singular Patagonia fame, is readying to launch their second hotel project, this time in an urban environment. As of this month, Singular Santiago will be opening in the Lastarria district of Chile's capital.

The family-owned and -operated hotel invested almost \$20 million in the 70,000-squarefoot city center hotel. Local architect Federico Prieto led the
